1. In order for Band to be an enjoyable and valuable experience for everyone, students need to behave in the same way they would in all other aspects of school life. Here are some examples of how to "Be Responsible, Be Respectful, Be Successful" while you are at band.

Be Responsible:

- Arrive on time to rehearsals and performances
- Come prepared with all your equipment and music
- Take good care of your instrument
- Help to set up & pack up the chairs and stands

Be Respectful:

- Email your band coordinator if you are late or absent
- Listen carefully during rehearsals
- Sit quietly while other sections of the band are rehearsing
- Be polite to all members of our team, including teachers

Be Successful:

- Attend your weekly lessons with your tutor
- Practice your music so that you keep improving
- Ask for help if you need it
- Be proud to be in band and have fun

2. Students must supply their own ancillary items such as valve oil, cork grease, reeds, replacement band folder and method book if lost or damaged.
3. It is expected that students will attend all Band programmed activities except in unusual circumstances. Being in band is like being in a sports team – every member has an important part to play and if someone is missing this makes things harder on everyone else.
4. Students are expected to make a 12-month commitment to their Band.
